Todd and I are really honored and appreciative for being invited to do another Kennel Visit in The Pomeranian Review for our RobCary Poms. Our last visit was almost 4 years ago and we are very proud of the progress we have made in producing outstanding cream Poms.

I started training and showing dogs as a teenager in the 1960s with my German Shepherd, Rolf Von Yantis, CD and then raised, trained and showed Shelties in obedience and conformation in the 1970s and 80s. I started Rob Cary Kennels in 1976 which grew to become Rob Cary Pet Resort in 1997 with the help of Todd's architectural talent and hard work building our new facilities. I took a break from showing in the mid-1980s after my

and showed his Golden Retriever, Kandi to her CD and CDX during our engagement and early in our marriage. Kandi lived to 18 years old and was great with my last three Shelties as well as with Sobe when we got him from Tony Cabrera and Fabien Arienti, Starfire Poms in 2000. Two years ago we

purchased a beautiful Bullmastiff Maggie who became Todd's buddy and show project. Todd recently finished Maggie, now CH Warden Del Toro's Iron Lady of RobCary. She is a wonderful companion and serves as the muscle back up for the Pom alarm system. Todd designed our home on a hill in Bulverde, Texas just north of San Antonio. It was completed in 2009 and we love it. The Poms have three big, oak covered yards on almost ½ acre to run and play in and of course they spend much of their time between the house and dog room. The house is designed around the dog yards so I can see them from almost every room. The older retired Poms are permanent fixtures in the house while the ones being shown must spend more time in the cooler and darker dog room and study.

BISA CH Starfire's RobCary Sobe It, Sobe was our first Pom, we searched for a year and a half for the right Pom and are grateful to Tony and Fabien for allowing us to purchase Sobe as a puppy. Sobe finished with me handling him at 15 months old. Tony showed Sobe a few months later at Westminster 2002 and won BOB, what an exciting day! to mature I started specializing him. In 2004 Sobe was the #7 Pom and won a BISA all with me as his owner handler. Sobe will be 14 years old in March, we share the same birthday and he shares my heart. He still loves to travel with me and chase (slowly) the Pom girls. Sobe only sired a few litters but he is behind many of our RobCary Champions and in 2013 qualified for his ROM when one of his last daughters, CH RobCary's Silver

Star, Tatiana, finished her Championship at 4 years old in less than 3 months. Our friend and handler Cheri Koppenhaver did a beautiful job of showing Tatiana and finished her with 3 majors, multiple BOS wins over specials and a BOB over specials. Tatiana will be bred at her next season.

Tatiana's first litter sired by Peter Petterson's white import, Bai Wan Zer Of Chiao Li Ya produced our beautiful GCH RobCary Silver Sensation, Hobbes. Hobbes finished his Championship at 10 months old with 3 majors in 2012 and finished his GCH in only 9 shows at 19 months old in 2013. Hobbes is proving his value as a sire producing some gorgeous puppies in his first litters. Tatiana's second litter sired by Christy Murphy's white GCH BC N WGA What's Your Flava produced our exciting young Champion RobCary's Ultimate Silver Fantasy, Trevor, who finished in his first

four shows at 6 months old with back to back 5 point majors and a BOB over specials. At 11 months old Trevor needs only one major to complete his GCH. He is a stunning cream sable with excellent structure and movement. I think Trevor is the nicest male I have bred so far.

Sobe's last litter with CH Starfire's Between The Sheet, ROMX, Satin produced the gorgeous CH Starfire's RobCary Constantino, Tino who was the #2 dog All Breeds in Mexico in 2012 and Starfire's RobCary Winter Dream, Natasha. Natasha was shown a short time in 2013 by our friend and handler Mendy Gleason. Natasha needs a major to finish and is coming back into coat now. Hopefully we can finish her before she comes in season as she will be probably be bred to CH RobCary's Silver Starlight at her next season. Natasha has produced one champion daughter, CH RobCary's Silver Dreamweaver, Selina, co-owned with Linda Pelz. Selina is due to have puppies sired by Jan Shars White Knight. Another beautiful daughter, RobCary's Silver Moon Over Cosmos, Luna, co-owned with Robin Lane has 10 points including a 5 point major won at 6 months old and a BOB over 4 specials at 8 months old. Robin also has a new litter of 3 sired by GCH RobCary's Silver Sensation out of her lovely Lexi, Kouterie's Alexandra At Cosmos. We are very excited by this beautiful litter of 3, a white/cream male and female and a lovely orange female.

produced 7 Champions to date. Natasha, only needing a major to finish will make Champion #8 for Satin and #7 for Sobe. Satin is now almost 13 years old and queen of the house.

Satin's cream sable son CH RobCary's Silver Frost, Foster, is the sire of Bronze GCH RobCary's Come Blow Your Horn, Gabriel who won BOB and BEST BBE at the 2013 AKC/Eukanuba National Championship show in Orlando. It was such an exciting day and a great honor to win over the lovely Pom entry. Gabriel's dam is CH RobCary's Gabriella, a Sobe x Satin granddaughter. Foster's orange sister, CH RobCary's Bit O My Heart produced our CH RobCary's Evangeline, sired by Shauna Jenkin's CH Great River's Sunbeam Royce. Evangeline needs two majors to complete her GCH and she is in season now and will be bred to Jan Shars White Knight. Foster's cream sable sister RobCary's Silver Dancer, Tanji, has produced three Champions, CH RobCary's Silver Star, Tatiana, CH RobCary's Simply Marvelous, Marla who finished with a 5 point major at the Houston Toy Club show and a BOB over 4 specials and CH RobCary's Silver Starlight, Star who finished at 9 months old with 4 majors and won Best Junior in Sweeps at the March 2013 APC National. Marla's sister Marilyn needs one major to complete her Championship.

In 2010 we purchased a pretty orange female puppy from Ruth Wagner who became CH Wagner's Sashay To RobCary, Sasha. Sasha finished at 14 months old and was bred three times to our beautiful cream CH Starfire's

ROB CARY TOO COOL, T.C., producing GCH RobCary's Song Of My Heart, Sonja in her first litter, CH RobCary's Travelin Rose in her second litter and RobCary's Bit Of Elegance Of CinMar, Ella in her third litter. Sonja is co-owned with Pam Hutto and has a beautiful baby boy sired by Gabriel. Sonja finished her Grand Championship with back to back 5 point majors, BOS over specials, BOB over 7 specials and a Group 4. Before she was a year old Sonja had finished her Championship with multiple BOS wins over specials and had 15 points towards her GCH. Rose completed her Championship at 13 months old and is due any day now to have her puppies sired by Jan Shars White Knight. Ella is co-owned with Cindy Onosko, CinMar Poms. Cindy also owns BISS CH. ROBCARY'S DEVIL MADE ME DO IT BN RN NA NAJ, Hanz, winner of Best Veteran and 1st AOM at the March 2010 APC National. Sasha's last litter was sired by Hobbes. She is now retired, spayed and placed with a sweet couple who will spoil her well.

When we first met Tony and Fabien they were showing a gorgeous silver cream girl who became CH Starfire's Silver Moon. I loved her color and quality and have worked hard to breed high quality creams along with our lovely oranges. If we do not fight the animal rights activists and educate the general public and elected officials I fear we may lose these rights in the near future.
